

Training for Researchers and Staff at the National Marrow Donor Program in the Use of IRBManager

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1.0 IRBManager

1.1 What is IRBManager?

IRBManager is an online submission, workflow, and data management system for the National Marrow Donor Program (NMDP) Institutional Review Board.

2.0 Login

2.1 Non-NMDP employees:

Existing user:

- 1. Go to https://nmdp.my.irbmanager.com/
- 2. Your User Name is your email address
- 3. Click on 'Forgot Password' if you need to reset your password
 - 3.1 You will receive an email with a link to reset your password

Note: If you do not use the email address associated with your account in IRBManager, you will not be able to reset the password. Should this occur, contact IRBStaff@nmdp.org in order to verify the email address on file. Do not create a new account. Duplicate accounts will not be merged. If you need to update your email address on file, contact <u>IRBStaff@nmdp.org</u>

New user:

- 4. Click 'Click here to register'
- 5. Enter your email address on the first screen
- 6. You will be required to answer all the questions in the registration form
- 7. Once you register, you will receive an email with a link to reset your password. You must use this link within 24 hours. If you do not change your password within 24 hours, you will need to click on 'Forgot Password?' to have a new link sent.

2.2 NMDP employees:

- 1. If you are logging in to IRBManager for the first time, contact <u>IRBStaff@nmdp.org</u> to ensure you have access to the IRBManager Okta account.
- 2. Upon confirming access with IRB staff, go to https://nmdp.my.irbmanager.com/
- 3. Use your Okta login by clicking on the link next to Okta login

2.3 How do I reset my password?

Click on 'Forgot Password?' to reset your password. You will receive an email with a link to reset your password. This link will expire within 24 hours. If you do not receive this email, check your spam/junk folder.

As a security precaution, IRBManager locks your account after three incorrect password attempts. It is recommended that you reset your password after two incorrect attempts. If your account is locked, use 'Forgot Password?' to reset your password and unlock your account.

3.0 Navigating the Home Page (also known as the DASHBOARD)

3.1 Actions

This is your Home/Dashboard screen. Use left-hand side Actions to start new xForms. For studies with which you are already associated, start a new xForm by first clicking on the study link under 'My Studies' (see section 3.6).

3.2 Messages

This heading is an area that the IRB will use for general communication to all the users within the system. Only displayed when there are current messages.

3.3 Studies

This area shows any studies with which the user is associated as Principal Investigator, Coordinator, Sub-Investigator, Administrative Contact, or other research staff. Click on the underlined link to view the details of the studies with which you are associated.

3.4 xForms

IRBManager uses web-based forms called xForms. The xForms section shows the forms currently being processed at this time for the user.

xForms (5 Active)

- You have <u>2 unsubmitted</u> xForms.
- You have <u>3 xForms</u> being processed at a later stage.
- There are <u>1 xForms</u> awaiting your attention.

In the above view of the DASHBOARD:

- You have 2 unsubmitted xForms.
 - The user currently started 2 xForms (submissions) but clicked "Save for Later" or closed out of the form without submitting the form.
 - Note: By clicking the link, '2 unsubmitted', the user can go straight to the unsubmitted xForms.
- You have 3 xForms being processed at a later stage.
 - The user has submitted 3 forms that are currently awaiting review and signature by the PI or are being processed by the IRB.
 - Click on the '3 xForms' link to see the current stage of each xForm
- You have xForms in error (not shown in screenshot).
 - The user has some forms that have errors. This is a software issue, and the user must notify the IRB office if they receive this notification.
 - $\circ~$ Note: If the user has an xForm in error, the user can click the underlined link and go straight to the xForm in error.
- There are 1 xForms awaiting your attention.
 - The user has 1 xForms that currently need action by the user (e.g., review and signature required, revisions requested by the IRB).
 - Note: By clicking the link, '1 xForms' the user can go straight to the xForms that need the user's attention.

3.5 Events

The events section of the DASHBOARD shows the total number of open events and the number of events categorized by name, such as Continuing Review, Initial Submission, or Amendment. The drop-down following 'Only show events where I am:' will allow you to show the events according to your role in the associated study.

By clicking into the event, you can view event details:

- Study: Study IRB number
- Site: NMDP Network Number (if available) and the name of the institution
- **PI:** Principal investigator's name
- **Type:** the type of event, which could include Initial Submission, Continuing Review, Adverse Event/Unanticipated, etc.
- **Started:** the date the event first started
- **Steps:** each event will have the steps listed. When the NMDP IRB has completed these actions, the complete column will be marked 'yes'.

3.5.2 Event Actions

Actions in the event details screen on the left-hand side are as follows:

- Attachments: shows the attachments related to the event detail
 - $\circ~$ Generated Docs shows the approval documents associated with the study
- **xForms:** shows the form used to create the event.

• **Done:** returns the user to the next most logical page depending on previous actions.

This is a list of all the active studies and site(s) with which the user is associated. Note: A study is not created under My Studies when a user submits an xForm. A study is created when the IRB determines that the study is ready for review. From your DASHBOARD, you can view the following information regarding your studies:

- The study number.
- The site where the project is taking place.
- The PI name.
- The study title.
- Expiration date of the project (if blank study has not yet been approved).
- Status: This will depend on whether the study is still under initial review or if elsewhere within the project's lifecycle. Statuses can include Active, Closed to enrollment, Data analysis, Data collection, Disapproved, On hold, Open to accrual, Pending Approval, Study Completed, Terminated, or Withdrawn.
- Reference Doc(s): will display documents that have been approved by the IRB. Note: this field will likely be blank as Reference Doc(s) are not being populated on the study-sites. Approved study-site documents will be displayed under Attachments (see section 3.6.2.1).

By clicking the small arrow to the right of Project, Site, PI, Title, Expires, and Status, you can sort the studies accordingly.

- Study can be sorted by Project Number
- Site can be sorted alphabetically
- PI is sorted alphabetically
- Title is sorted alphabetically
- Expiration dates are sorted by numerical date
- Status is grouped and sorted alphabetically

3.6.2 Study-Site Contacts

Study-site contacts are directly associated with a specific site on the study. They have access to make submissions specific to their study-site. This section lists the contacts associated with the study.

Current study-site contacts can add or remove other study-site contacts:

- Select a study under 'My Studies' on the homepage.
- Click on 'Start xForm' on the left hand-side under the Actions and select the Add/Remove Study-Site Contacts xForm. If the new contact's email is not populating, the xForm will have an option to click on a link to add a new contact to the system.

3.6.3 Study Contacts

Study Contacts are comprised of the central study-level protocol team and can be listed under the main study details (separate from being listed as a study-site contact under the MASTER study-site). Study Contacts have access to the IRB-approved study sites and can view existing Events and submissions for approved participating sites. They can also see pending xForms, what stage they are in, and who started them for already approved study-sites.

Study Contacts can see all the study-sites they are associated with under 'Studies':

Studies (16 Active)

- You are associated with **<u>16 active</u>** Studies and **<u>17 total</u>** Studies.
- You are the Primary Contact for <u>**1** active</u> and <u>**1** total</u> Studies.
- You are the Research Staff for <u>1 active</u> and <u>1 total</u> Studies.
- You are the Study Contact for <u>15 active</u> and <u>16 total</u> Studies.

*active means approved by the NMDP IRB

For study-sites that are **approved** (active) by the NMDP IRB:

• To view study-site activities, select the site from the list of 'My Studies'. Pending xForms will appear under the left-hand side Actions menu or under the corresponding Event. Note: an Event is created when IRB Pre-Review is completed and the xForm has moved to the next stage (see section 5.1)

For study-sites that are **pending** NMDP IRB approval:

- The study-site is created when the IRB Pre-Review is completed and will appear under 'Studies'. Note: 'My Studies' only shows sites that have already been approved.
- To view the site's Initial Submission prior to the IRB Pre-Review, the study contact will need to ask the submitter to add them as a collaborator on the **NMDP sIRB Study-Specific Local Context Worksheet** xForm (see section 4.1.2).
- After the IRB Pre-Review is completed, the xForm can be viewed under the Site Initial Submission Event.

3.7 Find Study

Users can search by PI name or complete NMDP IRB study number (e.g., IRB-1991-0002) to find a study with which the user is associated. Note: A study is not created when a user submits an xForm. A study is created when the IRB determines that the study is ready for review.



3.8 Help

Under **Help** you can contact the NMDP IRB Staff by choosing 'Contact Administrator'. Page help is currently disabled. Use this manual for assistance with using IRBManager.

3.9 User's Settings

Allows the user to edit their profile settings. By clicking on your Settings, you will access My Settings.

Under My Settings you can:

- 1. Change your password
- 2. Change your profile
- 3. Change your phone number
- 4. Change your address
- 5. View last 25 logins
- 6. Create an email signature

4.0 Managing forms in IRBManager (xForms)

Users submitting to the NMDP IRB will submit the xForm appropriate to the type of request (e.g., new study, amendment, continuing review). To know which xForm to complete, read the description next to each form after clicking 'Start xForm'.

There are two places where an xForm can be started:

1. The xForms below are started from your Dashboard. On your home/dashboard, click 'Start xForm' on the left and then choose the appropriate xForm.

- Add New Contact to IRBManager
- Human Subjects Research Determination Form
- Initial Application for Biomedical Studies
- Initial Application for Social and Behavioral Sciences
- NMDP sIRB Study-Specific Local Context Worksheet
- Single IRB Signatory Institution Enrollment and Local Context Form

2. The study-specific xForms below are started from your study-site. First click the link for the study under 'My Studies'; then click 'Start xForm' on the left and then choose the appropriate xForm.

4.1 Completing an xForm

The questions in the xForms are directed by the answers given. For example, if you mark that the study does not involve NMDP donors, the form will not ask subsequent questions about NMDP donors. Changing responses on the form will enable subsequent questions that were hidden or hide questions that are no longer applicable.

To navigate an xForm, click "Next" to move on to the next page of the xForm. Click "Save for Later" to stop working on the form. The xForm can then be reopened by going to the xForm link under "Actions."

Most questions on the form are required (the question will be labelled "Required"). All required questions on the form must be completed before submitting. If they are not, a

red error message will appear. The system will not allow you to continue until the field has been populated.

All required questions on a page must be completed before clicking 'Next'. To skip to another page on the form without answering all questions on the page at that time, use the navigation drop-down at the top of the page.

4.1.1 Adding Contacts

Some questions ask for a study contact. Type in the name or email address of the contact and choose the appropriate contact from the list that appears. If the contact does not appear, they are not included in the system. Click on the link provided to add a contact to the system:

A new tab will open. Enter the required information for the new contact. Click 'Submit' to activate the new contact. Note: this action only pertains to the Contact Form. You may click 'Submit' or 'Save for Later' to continue working on the main application. In a moment, you should be able to select the new contact from the drop-down list.

4.1.2 Adding Collaborators

Collaborators can be added to an xForm to view, edit, manage, or submit the form. To add a collaborator, click on the 'Collaborators' link on the top of the page:

4.1.3 Attaching a Document

To attach a document:

- 1. Click "Add Attachment" on specified attachment questions.
- 2. Do not change the name of the document. The NMDP IRB Notice of Action will display the file name of the documents as the name of the attachements.
- 3. Select the type of attachment if that option is available. On some questions, only a certain type of document is intended to be attached, and the type is preset.

- 4. Click the "Select" button to locate the file on your computer (files can also be attached from Dropbox or Box)
- 5. Click "Attach" to finish the process.

4.2 New study applications

From your Dashboard, under the action menu on the far-left side, select one of the following:

- 1. Start an Initial Application for Biomedical Study **or** Start Initial Application for Social and Behavioral Sciences Study (These applications should be used for new studies.)
- 2. Start xForm
 - a. Gives the option to start one of the above forms or to start the 'Add New Contact to IRBManager' form, which is used to create a username and login for a contact not in the IRBManager system.
 - b. Click on the name of the form to start the form.

4.2.1 Submitting an xForm

Before submitting an xForm, review the form completely. Changes cannot be made once an xForm is submitted, unless the IRB or PI requests changes.

After all pages on the form have been completed, the submission screen will appear. "Submit" will need to be clicked to complete the submission.

If you are not the PI, the form will go to the PI for signature. They will receive an email from IRBManager indicating their review and signature is required; the email will contain a link that will take them to the form. If the PI wants to return the form to the submitter, they will have the opportunity; otherwise, the PI signs and submits the form.

Note: If the PI does not see the email from IRBManager, they should check their Spam/Junk folder and make sure to mark emails from IRBManager as safe.

The PI can also access the form from their Dashboard. Under the xForms section of their Dashboard, they will see an xForm awaiting attention:

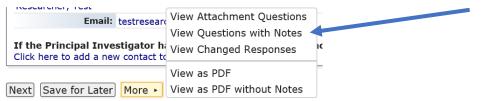

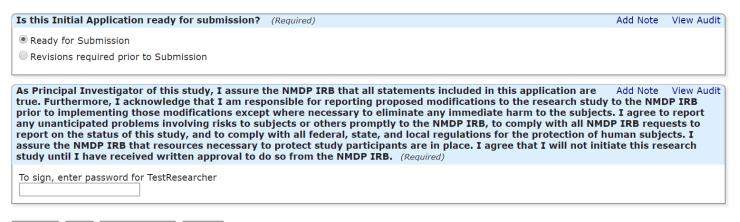
4.3.1 Making requested revisions to the xForm

If the PI has indicated that revisions are required, the form will go back into the Data Entry stage. The submitter will receive an email with revisions required. Click on the link in the email or access the xForm from your dashboard.

To view PI notes, click on 'More' button and select 'View Questions with Notes'



After making changes, click Submit. The form will go back to PI for signature. If the form is Ready for Submission, the PI will sign the form by entering their IRBManager password:

The form will now be submitted to the NMDP IRB office for review and will move into the 'IRB Pre-Review' stage.

4.3.2 Clarifications required by the IRB Staff

If IRB Staff requires clarifications, you will receive an email with Clarifications Required. Click on the link in the email or access the xForm from your dashboard to respond to the clarifications.

If there are any specific questions requiring clarifications, click on 'More' button at the bottom of the form and select 'View Questions with Notes.' Otherwise, navigate to 'Respond to IRB Questions' to provide a response:

After all pages on the form have been completed, the submission screen will appear. "Submit" will need to be clicked to complete the submission.

If you are not the PI, the form will go to the PI for signature. They will receive an email indicating their review and signature is required. If PI wants to return the form to the submitter, they will have the opportunity; otherwise, the PI signs and submits the form.

If IRB Staff requires clarifications, you will receive an email with Clarifications Required. Follow instructions above.

5.0 IRB Determinations

The IRB has completed the review, and the IRB Office is preparing the decision notification to the research team.

5.1 Checking the status of an xForm

Click on xForms under your Home screen or 'xForms' under 'My Documents & Forms' on the left-hand side of the screen to see a list of all xForms with which you are associated (either as a PI, administrative contact, coordinator, etc.).

- Action: If a form can be deleted or copied for an amendment, those options will display in this column. Note that an xForm can only be deleted when in the Data Entry stage.
- Form: Name of the xForm
- Identifier: This is generally the PI associated with the project
- **Owner:** The owner of the form will be the user who started the xForm until a project is created (a project will be created within IRBManager after the IRB has sent the project for review), and then the form is owned by the project
- **Stage:** This is the current stage that the form is in. Stages will vary by form, but in general will be the following:
 - Data Entry: Form is currently with the user/submitter either to complete or make changes.
 - $\circ~$ PI Signature for Research Staff Submission: If the PI is not the submitter, this is the stage where the PI reviews and submits the form.
 - IRB Pre-Review: Stage that the IRB Office will screen the application for completeness and either request further information/documentation (clarifications) or assign for review. Note: this stage may include Administrative review and approval, if applicable.

- Expedited Review: The project is being reviewed at the expedited level.
- Full Board Review: The project is being reviewed by the convened board.
- Final Processing: The IRB has completed the review, and the IRB Office is preparing the decision notification to the research team.

You can also check the status of the xForm from within the event (see 3.2 for finding an xForm on an event). Note: the xForm will be 'owned' by the type of event with which it is associated (i.e. initial submission, continuing review, amendment [once the amendment is submitted]).

5.2 IRB Decision Notification

Once the IRB Office or the IRB reviewer(s) have completed their review, the research team will receive an email detailing the IRB decision. The appropriate approval/determinaton letter will be attached.

- **Approved**: No changes are requested by the IRB; the investigator may initiate the study or continue the study, or may implement the changes to the protocol.
- **Approved with Stipulations**: Study may <u>not</u> be initiated until Stipulations are met.
 - The form will go to the Data Entry stage. If changes are requested to specific documents, please replace current documents with red-lined copies. Click on the green arrows to replace a document, rather than deleting the document and adding the new one. State your response in the following question of the xForm 'Please use this box to respond to any IRB questions, if needed'. Alternatively you may attach a formal response letter with any additional attachments under 'Add additional attachments, if needed'. Once the revisions are submitted, the form will either go back to the primary and secondary reviewers or back to the Full Board. If additional changes are requested, the form will return to Data Entry for revisions are met.
- **Disapproved:** The research is not approved.
- **Deferred:** Substantive clarifications or modifications are required by the IRB before the research may be initiated or continued beyond the current approval period, or before the protocol change may be implemented. The convened IRB must review the response to the deferral.
 - $\circ~$ Form will go back to data entry and be routed back through the IRB Office and to the full board for review.
- **Tabled:** If the convened IRB is unable to adequately review a study due to lack of time or loss of quorum, the study will be reviewed at the next full board meeting.

6.0 Using the NMDP IRB as a Single IRB

Signatory Institutions relying on the NMDP IRB have a Site Management page in IRBManager. This page is created when a site enrolls in the NMDP single IRB (sIRB). Primary contacts associated with a Signatory Institution have access to their site under `My Studies':

Click on the blue link under "Study" to view site information and make submissions associated with the site.

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Contacts listed under Site Contacts act as the point of contact for their institution. They can submit annual sIRB review, update their boilerplate template language, and request other site documents to be approved (see section 4.0).
