## **Housing Barriers**

- Adult (N=31)
  - Cost/affordability of housing
  - Lack of insurance benefits for lodging
  - Lack of housing options available

- Pediatric (N=15)
  - Lack of housing options available
  - Housing options full/long waiting lists
  - Cost/affordability of housing

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## Housing Resources Available

- Adult (N=31)
  - Discounted hotel rates (84%)
  - Local hotel/motel (58%)
  - Housing owned in collaboration with another entity (39%)

- Pediatric (N=15)
  - Ronald McDonald House (80%)
  - Discounted hotel rates (73%)
  - Local hotel/motel (33%)

## **Adult Housing Solutions**

- Local lodging options: Hotels & apartment complexes
  - o Contract for special rates with local hotels, lodging options
  - Refer to local apartment complex that provides a free apartment for patients during lengthy stays
- Programs
  - Company's foundation has bought and remodeled a house; purchasing two other houses (6 units)
  - o Contract with Assisted Living Organization

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#### **Adult Housing Solutions**

continued

- Financial Assistance
  - o Supplement cost of hotel rooms on campus
  - o Small fund that helps with lodging costs
- Other Assistance
  - o Family members sleep in room with patient
  - $\circ \ \text{Provide housing list}$

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## **Pediatric Housing Solutions**

- Local housing
  - o Working with local hotels to offer discounts
- Timing
  - o Assess needs at time of referral
  - o Provide housing resources at initial meeting
- Workforce
  - Family resource specialist position was created to help address numerous financial needs,
  - o Brainstorming other resources (family, friends)

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## Pediatric Housing Solutions

- Financial support
  - Foundations
  - National Children's Cancer Society



- Ronald McDonald House
  - New Ronald McDonald House was built with 15 transplant rooms on 2 floors separate from the rest of the house.
  - The Ronald McDonald House will prioritize cancer/BMT patients over other referrals received

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## Caregiver-Availability Barriers

- Adult (N=31)
  - Patient has limited social ties (e.g., no one to ask, estranged from family)
  - Caregiver would lose income
  - Caregiver cannot commit to the required time period

- Pediatric (N=15)
  - Caregiver would lose income
  - Caregiver has family members to care for
  - Caregiver's employer does not provide time off/leave of absence

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## Caregiver Resources Available

- Adult (N=31)
  - Allowed to have multiple caregivers (90%)
  - Hire a caregiver using private funds (71%)
  - Hire caregiver using public/government insurance benefit (23%)

- Pediatric (N=15)
  - Allowed to have multiple caregivers (73%)
  - Hire a caregiver using private funds (27%)
  - Child protective services (14%)

#### Adult Caregiver-Availability Solutions

#### • Multiple caregivers

- Assist patient with identifying multiple caregivers as needed
- o Utilize online/shared calendars for multiple caregivers
  - mylifeline.org
  - · otsahelpinghands.org
- o Discounted parking

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## Adult Caregiver-Availability Solutions

#### • Early discussion

- Orientation
- o Emphasize the importance of committed caregiver

#### Funding

Create fund to help offset caregiver costs

## Adult Caregiver-Availability Solutions

- Social work support and support groups
  - o Caregiver support group
  - o Availability of social worker
  - Close monitoring of caregiving to provide support and resources before a crisis occurs.

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# Adult Caregiver-Availability Solutions continued

- Working with caregivers
  - Educate caregiver on FMLA; provide caregiver letters for employers
  - No requirements for caregiver to stay the whole day with a patient.

#### Adult Caregiver-Availability Solutions

#### continued

- Community resources
  - o Utilizing church and community groups
  - Relationship with an enhanced assisted living facility that will take auto transplants for a 2 week stay.
- Other
  - Providing med alert buttons when there is no caregiver

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#### Pediatric Caregiver-Availability Solutions

- Financial support
  - o Centers offer financial support
  - o NMDP financial assistance program
- Community resources
  - Provide assistance for caregiver by being present with patient and allowing them to leave the facility
- · Help families with problem-solving
  - Meet as a care team then with family to talk about caregiver agreement created for the situation
