## What Do We Hope to Do?

- Comprehensive autotransplant outcomes (in process)
- Patient reported quality metrics (planning)
- Center-specific outcome improvement strategies
- Electronic structured data sharing strategies

## Pitfalls

- Loss of voluntary initiative in QA/QI
- Lose focus on outcomes vs. process quality
- Excessive focus on "one size fits all" quality initiatives
- Failure to emphasize patient-reported quality metrics
- Failure to emphasize collaboration with government and other insurers.
