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Study Design

- The Manufacturing Feasibility Study was apheresis center (AC) focused, including a subset of 5 NMDP Network ACs
- Each participating AC performed testing for sterility, identity and potency and participated in a lot release process
- AC test results were received and reviewed by the NMDP Quality Unit



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Site Selection

- There are three types of centers in the Network:
 - Hospital-based
 - Blood Center-based
 - Independent

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Study Objectives



 To determine if it is feasible to have test results for sterility, identity and potency completed and reviewed prior to release of the product to the courier for distribution to the transplant center (TC)



Secondary Objective

 To determine if it is feasible to have test results for sterility, identity and potency completed and reviewed prior to release to the TC



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Sample Testing

- Sterility
 - Gram Stain
 - Bacterial culture
- Identity & Potency
 - MNC count





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Lot Release




- Tests for sterility (Gram stain only), potency and identity should be completed prior to release of the product to the courier for distribution to the transplant center
- Test results sent between AC and centralized Quality Unit at NMDP
