





## **Transplant Support Assistance (TSA) Grant**

For allogeneic transplants facilitated through NMDP®/Be The Match®

The TSA grant is available thanks to Be The Match Foundation®

## To be eligible for TSA, recipients must meet all of these requirements:

- 1. Has been living in the United States.
- 2. Had full allogeneic transplant through NMDP/Be The Match (excludes DLI, boost, etc).
- 3. Transplant was within the last twelve (12) months.
- 4. a) Household monthly net (take-home) income is within the income cap below:

Number in household	All states (except AK & HI), incl. DC & PR	Alaska	Hawaii
1	\$5,000	\$6,200	\$5,700
2	\$6,700	\$8,400	\$7,700
3	\$8,500	\$10,600	\$9,700

- b) And household income doesn't exceed household costs by more than \$200 a month.
- 5. Transplant center rep affirms eligibility and submits application by email: patientgrants@nmdp.org or fax: 763-406-8169.

## Important things to know about applying for a TSA grant:

- 1. Receiving a financial grant can negatively impact other forms of assistance you may have. Speak with your social worker if you are not sure if this affects you.
- 2. TSA can be given once within the first twelve (12) months after an eligible transplant.
- 3. Complete the application thoroughly. Missing information will cause delays or denial.
- 4. Funding for TSA is limited; we cannot guarantee approval regardless of eligibility.
- 5. If approved, the amount of money granted is based on available funding.
- 6. The transplant center representative who sends the application, will be notified of the decision usually within fifteen (15) business days.
- 7. Once approved, payment will be mailed through the US Postal Service usually within fifteen (15) business days of the notice of approval.
- 8. If the payment is not received within four (4) weeks of the notice of grant approval, contact your transplant center representative for assistance.
